The Water User Group (WUG) Mount Enterprise WSC is located in Rusk County within the water planning region known as the East Texas Regional Water Planning Area (ETRWPA, or Region I). The East Texas Regional Water Planning Group (ETRWPG) is in the process of updating the regional water plan for the ETRWPA to be adopted in 2021 Plan.
